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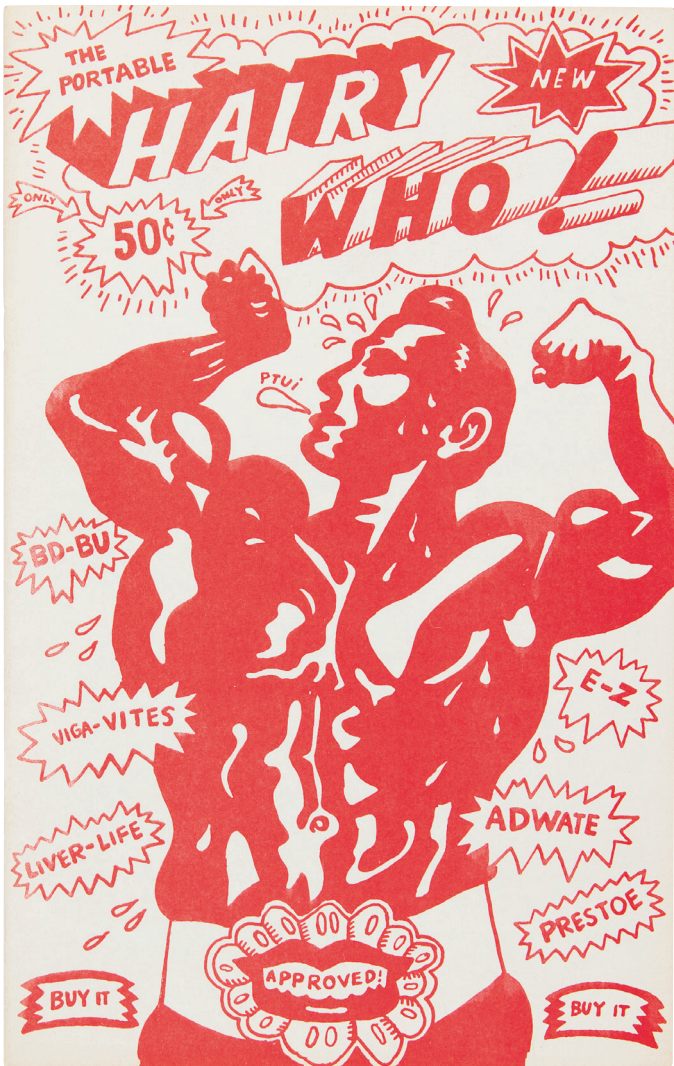
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The Collected Hairy Who Publications 1966–1969

The Hairy Who were six Chicago artists renowned for their hallucinatory visions of the human body. Much of the group's legacy rests on four self-published "comic" books made to accompany their exhibitions. Among the first artist's books executed in full color, these publications are an exemplary model of collaboration. The key to their influence, however, is their formal inventiveness. Every page teems with unforgettable characters rendered in energetic lines and high-key color.

Collected here for the first time in a single volume, these rare publications are reproduced actual-size and in full color. Accompanying them are a scholarly essay and an extensive archive of Hairy Who posters, exhibition photographs, and ephemera.
